Planning Commission Report

Ginger Patterson presented the Andrew DeGol Minor Subdivision (*Property Code:03-12-2*) located on Tipton Road in Antis, Township, Blair County. The purpose of this subdivision is to create a lot to construct a single family home. The subdivision was approved on the motion of Supervisor Caracciolo seconded by Supervisor Matuszewski followed by a 4-0 voice vote

On the motion of Supervisor Caracciolo seconded by Supervisor Matuszewski followed by a 4-0 voice vote approval was given to accept the thirty day time extension that Balfurd's extended to the Township to consider their Land Development submission.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report was approved on the motion of Supervisor Caracciolo, seconded by Supervisor Matuszewski, followed by a 4-0 voice vote.

Bills in the amount of \$28,003.02 from the General Fund, \$23,819.43 from the Capital Reserve Fund, \$5,500.13 from the Stormwater Improvement Fund; \$54,237.87 from the C2P2 Grant Fund; and \$17,714.29 from the State Fund were approved for payment, on the motion of Supervisor Caracciolo, seconded Supervisor Matuszewski, followed by a 4-0 yes roll call vote.

New Business

On the motion of Supervisor Matuszewski seconded by Supervisor Caracciolo followed by a 4-0 voice vote approval was given to hire a seasonal employee at \$12/hour to assist with maintenance at the perk as well as other duties as assigned by the Road Foreman. This was included in the 2019 budget.
