The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Winterstein followed by prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment Period

There were no comments under the Public Comment Period.

Meeting Minutes

The July 11, 2024 Board of Supervisor Meeting Minutes were approved on the motion of Supervisor Bell, seconded by Supervisor Kustaborder, followed by a 5-0 voice vote.

Supervisors Reports

George Bell reported that the trail bulkhead on the stream is complete.

Solicitor's Report

The Solicitor had nothing to report.

Manager's Report

The Manager reported that the MSP temporary occupancy expires on Tuesday August 6. He also reported that we were awarded \$480K from the Green Light Go grant program.

On the motion of Supervisor Kustaborder, seconded by Supervisor Hornberger followed by a 5-0 voice vote authorization was given to accept the maintenance of a stop bar to be installed at Stadium Drive by PADOT.

Road Foreman Report

The Road Foreman reported:

- Paving prep work is complete
- Borrowed the borough pump to replace culvert on Watts Road
- Replaced pipe on Kerbaugh

Engineer's Report

The Township Engineer took no exception to the Tyler Stormwater waiver request to fencing around a detention pond. On the motion of Supervisor Hornberger, seconded by Supervisor Bell followed by a 5-0 voice vote approval was given to the waiver request contingent upon an indemnification agreement to hold harmless the Township.

Planning Commission Report

(There were no planning Commission Submissions for consideration).

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report and bills in the amount of \$38,435.59 from the General Fund, \$7,158.96 from the Capital Reserve Fund, and \$227 from the Stormwater Improvement Fund, on the motion of Supervisor Hornberger, seconded Supervisor Bell, followed by a 5-0 yes roll call vote.

New Business

On the motion of Supervisor Winterstein, seconded by Supervisor Kensinger followed by a 5-0 voice vote authorization was given to release payment to Allegheny Trucks inc. \$111,022.97 for the 2025 International upon arrival.

On the motion of Supervisor Bell, seconded by Supervisor Kustaborder, followed by a 5-2 voice vote authorization was given to apply for a grant to complete a joint Comprehensive Plan with Bellwood Borough. Approval is contingent upon receiving formal approval from the borough.,
